ENROLLMENT

1. Most classes have limited enrollment. Classes will be scheduled according to class period and availability on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. The school reserves the right to cancel any course that does not meet minimum enrollment. You will be contacted if a class is canceled or closed and will be offered a new class or will be given a full refund.
3. Unless otherwise noted, all classes receive 2.5 semester units (equivalent to $\frac{1}{2}$ semester of credit).
4. Student schedules with room locations and teachers' names are to be picked up (on the first day of classes) from the Main Office.

REGISTRATION

1. Registration will open on February 1, 2019, and must be completed by June 11, 2019. A late fee applies after this date.
2. Books are included for most classes unless otherwise indicated. Certain classes may have an additional lab fee or course requirement. Be sure to check the course descriptions.
3. A \$50.00 processing fee PER CLASS will be charged for late registration.

REFUNDS

1. Tuition is refundable on or before the deadlines listed above, minus a non-refundable \$50.00 processing fee per class.
2. Budgeting commitments must be made prior to the opening of the Summer Program; therefore, the school will NOT refund tuition for withdrawals after June 11, 2019.

CLASS CHANGES

1. The last day to make class changes will be Thursday, June 13, 2019.
2. A fee of \$50.00 will be charged to change a class.

CREDIT RECOVERY/REMEDICATION COURSES

All credit recovery/remediation courses meet for all of Period A and are worth 5 credits per semester.
Period B (in the afternoon) may be used for credit recovery.

ALGEBRA 1 REVIEW (SEMESTER 1 OR 2)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This course is designed for students who need credit for the first semester of Algebra I. Emphasis will be on evaluating expressions, solving equations and inequalities, factoring, and development problem solving skills. Tuition is \$395.00.

GEOMETRY REVIEW (SEMESTER 1 OR 2)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This course is for students who need credit for the first semester of Geometry. This course focuses on developing the ability to construct formal, logical arguments and proofs in geometric settings and problems. Advanced algebraic representation and deductive analysis of geometric relations are stressed throughout the course. Tuition is \$395.00.

BIOLOGY REVIEW (SEMESTER 1 OR 2)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This is a remediation course for students who need to make-up the first semester and/or second semester of Biology. The course offers a review of the topics covered in the first semester (such as biochemistry, cell processes, and genetics) or the second semester (such as evolution, physiology, and ecology). Both sections emphasize the scientific method and lab work. Tuition is \$495.00.

CHEMISTRY REVIEW (SEMESTER 1 OR 2)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This is a remediation course for students who need to make up the first semester and/or the second semester of Chemistry. The course offers a review of topics covered in the first semester (such as Matter, change, chemical equations and reactions, chemical formulas and bonding, stoichiometry, and gases and solutions) or the second semester (such as ions, acids and basis, energy and kinetics, electrochemistry, organic chemistry, biochemistry). Both sections emphasize the scientific method and lab work. Tuition is \$495.00.

SPANISH 1 REVIEW (SEMESTER 1 OR 2)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This is a remediation course for students who need to remediate the first semester, second semester, or full year of Spanish I. Tuition is \$395.00.

SPANISH II REVIEW (SEMESTER 1 OR 2)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This is a remediation course for students who need to remediate the first semester, second semester, or full year of Spanish II. Tuition is \$395.00.

SPANISH III REVIEW (SEMESTER 1 OR 2)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This is a remediation course for students who need to remediate the first semester, second semester, or full year of Spanish III. Tuition is \$395.00.

COMPOSITION/9TH GR ENGLISH REVIEW (SEMESTER 1 OR 2)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 1:00PM – 3:10PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 1:00PM – 3:10PM

This is a remediation course for students who need to make up the first semester or second semester of Composition. This course is a theme-based study of language, literature, and composition that will provide students with experience in reading, writing, speaking, and critical thinking while studying a range of diverse literary works. Students will learn how to compose a variety of pieces, organize ideas, and build vocabulary. Tuition is \$395.00.

WORLD LITERATURE/10TH GR ENGLISH REVIEW (SEMESTER 1 OR 2)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 1:00PM – 3:10PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 1:00PM – 3:10PM

This is a remediation course for students who need to make up the first semester or second semester of World Literature. This course offers a comparative approach to the study of literature from around the world and throughout the ages. Students explore timeless literary themes through epics, drama, poetry, short stories, and novels. Substantial amounts of reading combined with frequent and rigorous writing assignments challenge students to deepen their critical insights and sharpen their writing skills. Special emphasis is given to argumentation and literary analysis. Students write a research paper and deliver oral presentations using a variety of media. Tuition is \$395.00.

AMERICAN LITERATURE/11TH GR ENGLISH REVIEW (SEMESTER 1 OR 2)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 1:00PM – 3:10PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 1:00PM – 3:10PM

This is a remediation course for students who need to make up the first semester or second semester of US Literature. This course emphasizes in-depth reading and literary analysis of American poetry, fiction, drama, and other literary forms such as journals, letters, and speeches, with special emphasis given to exploring American identity and culture through our country's diverse literary voices. Students will refine their writing skills through integrated literature and composition units, while also developing strategies for achieving success on the SAT Verbal and Writing sections. Further challenges include a research paper and oral presentations on cross-curricular topics in American literature and history. Tuition is \$395.00.

THEOLOGY REVIEW (Blended/Hybrid class)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 1:00PM – 3:10PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 1:00PM – 3:10PM

Holy Family High School offers theology classes for all Catholic high school students needing to remediate a theology class. This class is offered as a hybrid/blended class. The teacher and students will meet according to the schedule established by the teacher. Tuition is \$395.00.

ADVANCEMENT COURSES

Advancement courses meet for all of Period A and are worth 5 credits per semester.

ALGEBRA 1 FOR GEOMETRY PLACEMENT

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM This course is designed for the Holy Family student who would like to take a full-year of Algebra I over the summer in order to take Geometry in the fall. This course focuses on the understanding of the symbolic language of mathematics. Algebraic concepts and skills are developed and used in a variety of problem-solving situations. Tuition is \$595.00.

GEOMETRY FOR ALGEBRA 2 PLACEMENT

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This course, only open to Holy Family students, focuses on developing the ability to construct formal, logical arguments and proofs in geometric settings and problems. Algebraic representation and deductive analysis of geometric relations are stressed throughout the course. Tuition is \$595.00.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This semester course, open to ALL students, is designed to introduce students to the various skills, strategies, and rules of team sports and physical fitness. Active participation is an integral component of the class. Tuition is \$595.00.

HEALTH/P.E.

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This course, open to ALL students, provides practical information to support educated and proactive choices for a lifestyle of health and fitness. Various aspects of physical, mental, social, and spiritual health are explained and applied. Tuition is \$595.00.

*INTRODUCTION TO HIGH SCHOOL ENGLISH (Holy Family High School students only)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This is a six-week course designed for students who need to improve their English grammar and writing skills before entering high school. Students will review vocabulary, basic grammar, basic writing skills, and paragraph unity and coherence. Students will also write short critical analyses, based on their reading of short fiction.

Tuition is \$295.00.

*INTRODUCTION TO HIGH SCHOOL ALGEBRA (Holy Family High School students only)

Semester 1: June 14th – July 3rd 8:00AM – 12:40PM

Semester 2: July 8th – July 25th 8:00AM – 12:40PM

This is a six-week course is designed to support students who will be taking Algebra 1 in the fall and wish to get a head start. The topics covered during the class will be individualized according to the needs of the students enrolled.

Tuition is \$295.00.

***If Introduction to High School English and Introduction to High School Algebra are taken concurrently, then the total cost for both courses is \$395.00.**
